



“ICE” Your Cell Phone (In Case of Emergency)



It could save your life and notify loved ones!

Your cell phone can help emergency responders and healthcare workers to identify you and notify your loved ones.

Just program your cell phone’s contact list with the codeword
“ICE” (In Case of Emergency):

There are two ways to do this, and it is recommended that you do both.

Create ICE Entries in Your Phone’s Contact List

Simply add the word **ICE** in the Name, Title, Company, or other field that displays on your contact list; or

1. Open your cell phone contact list to create a new entry.
2. Enter the word **ICE** with the name and number of the person you would like contacted in an emergency.
3. To list multiple contacts name the entries **ICE 1, ICE 2, ICE 3.**

Examples: **ICE 1-Husband-Tom**
ICE 2-Mother-Mary
ICE 3-Son-Joe

Create an ICE Group

Create a new Group, and add to that group every person you have flagged with the **ICE** tag.

**Emergency workers look for the
codeword “ICE” when they
turn on your phone.**
